# **Booster Club Impact 2017-2018**

Last school year, through the generosity of its members, donors, and countless volunteers; the Booster Club provided more than \$44,450 in support of students and staff. Boosters have an impact on our school!

## September

- Provided funding for athletes to participate in fall sports totaling \$273.19
- Funded \$1251.87 toward the football team dinner prior to the Kickoff Classic versus Pullman.
- Purchased Trojan Memorial Field and State Championship signs placed on west fence line. Total \$1188.00.
- Provided funding for athletic team banners in gym totaling \$2500.00
- Purchased boulevard banners for the light poles around the high school totaling \$1517.82
- Provided funding for monthly staff appreciation events totaling \$550

### October

- Provided snacks to students that attend tutoring in the amount of \$300
- Funded the initial 2019 Grad Party fundraiser totaling \$500
- Purchased water filling stations for the gym, the 400 building (2), and the 500 building (total of 4) for a total of \$4317.71

### November

- Sponsored scholarships for students from the FHS Scholarship Foundation totaling \$2100
- Provided funding for the TDM Hollywood trip in the amount of \$600 (\$50/student)

#### December

- Sponsored the John McCrossin Memorial Basketball Classic and funded the Pep Band and TDM \$1000 each to participate (total \$2000)
- Provided funding of \$500 to offset the cost of raising awareness and promoting the Bond and Levy ballot issues.

### February

Provided \$300 to FBLA for the Chapter Dinner prior to State competition.

### March

- Co-sponsored the annual dinner auction and provided \$10726.64 to the FHS Scholarship Foundation and \$4640 for the purchase of pole vault landing pits.
- Co-sponsored the Commencement Bay Jazz Festival with the Music Department and provided \$7014.45 in net proceeds to the Music Department.
