September

- Provided funding for parking lot banners in the amount of \$2637.60

- Provided snacks/coffee to staff and alumni attending football games in the Alumni Zone in the amount of \$200.
- Provided funding for Phase 1 of Mary's Garden reconstruction in the courtyard in the amount of \$1500.00

October
